Health Care Landscape Report - COVID-19 and Telehealth Policy

[Is the Digital Divide the Newest Social Determinant of Health](#)

The COVID-19 pandemic has exposed yet another form of inequity, the digital divide. While some patients can access and use telehealth services, others, unfortunately, can not. Broadband support, technological devices, and digital literacy (the ability to use and understand technology) all contribute to whether a patient has the capability to access and utilize telehealth services. The inability to access telehealth services, especially during a time where it is the primary source of healthcare delivery, can negatively affect health outcomes and further exacerbate health disparities. The author highlights the disparities around the adoption and use of telehealth during the pandemic, poor broadband access in rural communities and addresses digital literacy.
