- Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program NOFO's
 - Part C Early Intervention Services (EIS) New Service Areas (HRSA-18-092)
 - ✓ *Potential* new Competitive Opportunity will open in FY 2022
 - ✓ Open to current RWHAP Part C EIS recipients and new organizations proposing to provide RWHAP Part C EIS funded services in new geographic service areas
 - Part C Capacity Development (HRSA-21-058)
 - ✓ This is an annual NOFO open to eligible organizations (not only current RHWAP recipients)
 - ✓ Next Funding Opportunity will open in FY 2022
 - ✓ The NOFO will fund HIV Care Innovation or Infrastructure Development activities

- HAB recommends referencing and reviewing the NOFO requirements if future opportunities become available
